2. **Minutes of the Meeting** held on 12<sup>th</sup> May 2008 were read, approved and signed by the Chairman.
  
3. **Matters Arising**

**Camping**

This has now been restricted to the permitted number of 28 days a year and the problems of last year have not been repeated.

**Village Hall Trust**

A donation of £750 would be made to the Village Hall Trust

**Bus Shelter**

A grant of £1710 has been offered by WSCC. The insurance policy has been checked and we can sub-contract and employ someone to build a bus shelter. The land belongs to the parish council. It was agreed that we would undertake to build it ourselves rather than purchase one; the existing base would be used and wooden roofing shingles were available. Max Davies to pursue this with some volunteer parishioners.

**Dogs**

The fouling on the football field has improved a bit, so the notice in the parish magazine seems to have had an effect.

**Singleton School**

Highways department had informed us that it is not a high priority. Response from Singleton Parish council not yet received.

4. **Correspondence**

**Pond Green**

A letter had been received from a parishioner suggesting the annual bonfire be moved to another location to prevent damage to trees. It was agreed that it should not be moved from its traditional location but could be moved slightly further from the oak tree.

## **5. Any Other Business**

### **Goodwood traffic**

It appears that the police had directed traffic from the Festival of Speed down the hill through the village. It was suggested that we write to the police before the Revival meeting.

### **The Paddock**

The Parish Council is surprised and dismayed to find that the developer of Manor Farm Barns has included the paddock in the plans. The parish council did not believe that this was the agreement as all the minutes indicate that it would be handed over to the parish council in perpetuity. The Chairman would write to Goodwood expressing our concern and disappointment.

### **Newhouse Lane signpost**

Tim Weeks offered to repaint this at no cost.

### **Allotment fence**

The fence next to the allotment on the Charlton road which was damaged by a car has not been repaired. The Chairman would let Goodwood know and confirm whose responsibility it is to repair it.

### **Wests' 200 Year Celebration**

This will be in 2009 and Peter West is considering holding a Wood Fair in New Barn field. It was confirmed this would be in keeping with the village and it was agreed that the Parish Council and the village would be supportive.
